Whew! It seems like only yesterday we were celebrating a fantastic Holy Week! Each service we had throughout Lent illustrated how the Holy Spirit is working in our community. We discussed throughout Lent getting rid of the bad habits and mess that we have in our lives, with a celebration an ecumenical reader's theater on Maundy Thursday and a service of word and song on Good Friday. On Easter Sunday, we had an awesome service celebrating Jesus's resurrection, with 71 people in worship! Praise God for Christ has risen!

We celebrated Easter, so now what is there? Everything in our society seems to be picking up for the summer and church seems to be slowing down. Christ has risen. So now what? 


# **6-Week Bible Study**


