Columbus CROP Walk 2023


OUR MISSION OFFERING IN OCTOBER WILL GO TO CHURCH WORLD SERVICE AND CROP WALK.

The Columbus/Fall River CROP Hunger Walk will be held on Oct 15th at 1:00 pm at Columbus UMC. Please let me know if you would be interested in a "long" walk this year. That group will meet at noon at Fireman's Park. Please contact Eileen Bennett to sign up.

Walkers have the option of being registered on-line or "off-line." Columbus CROP Walk can be found here: <u>https://events.crophungerwalk.org/2023/team/cumc</u>. A team has already been created for Columbus UMC. Walkers may join that team or create their own. The advantage of on-line teams is that teams can use social media and e-mails to solicit donations. Walkers may also do a Facebook fundraiser. Our Facebook page is here: <u>https://www.facebook.com/columbuswicropwalk</u>.We will also be accepting donations at church. Checks should be made out to COLUMBUS UMC and may be given to individual walkers, placed in the Offering plate, or mailed to church. All donations are due by October 29th.

25% of our proceeds will go to the Columbus/Fall River Food Pantry. Participants in the first CROP Hunger Walk in 1969 walked 20 miles in solidarity with an average woman's daily journey for clean water in some parts of the world. Because of CROP Hunger Walks in communities like Columbus, today that average walk for water is now only 3.4 miles.
